Entries: All exhibitors must provide the show office with a current negative coggins report for each horse brought on the show grounds. Entry form must be filled out completely, including all signatures, and must be accompanied by an open check before back numbers may be picked up.

**Online Entries are required via [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com).**

Schooling: Schooling will be permitted starting at noon the day before the show. Schooling will also be available prior to the start of the show on the day of competition as determined by the course designer.

Coggins: All exhibitors must provide the show office with a current negative coggins report for each horse brought onto the show grounds, regardless if they are showing. If the horse is showing, the coggins must be shown prior to picking up back number.

Awards: Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each division. Classics will place through sixth. Derbies will place through eighth.

**ADD-BACK CLASSIC:** All classics will be add-backs. Entry fee will be \$30. \$15 of the entry fee will contribute to the prize money for that classic. Prize money will be distributed as: 35%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 5%, 5%.

# CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

## Hunter/Equitation

GREEN HUNTER - Open to horses only in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher. Fences to be 2'6" and 3'. Both heights must be offered and judged together. To be eligible for green hunter status, horses may not have shown over fences 2'6" or higher prior to the current competition year. A horse is eligible for reinstatement of their 1st green year if they have not shown at more than (3) shows over fences at 2'6" or higher prior to August 1st of the competition year upon application to the SWVHJA office. The application will be reviewed by the Board of Directors. Horses are eligible for (1) reinstatement of Green status. SWVHJA Recognized.

LOW HUNTER - Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'.

WORKING HUNTER - Open to horses. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'3" or 3'6".

CHILDREN'S HUNTER - Open to juniors mounted on horses. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'. Management may combine this division with the Adult Amateur Hunter division if there are fewer than 3 entries.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER - Open to adult amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show. Fences 3'. Management may combine this division with the Children's Hunter division if there are fewer than 3 entries.

ADULT HUNTER PLEASURE - Open to horses or ponies ridden by an adult. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show.

JR. HUNTER PLEASURE - Open to horses ridden by a junior.

PONY HUNTER PLEASURE - Open to juniors mounted on ponies.

PLEASURE HUNTER CLASSIC- Open to horses and ponies placing 1st-3rd in the following classes; Adult Hunter Pleasure W/T, W/GAYP, W/T/C, Junior Hunter Pleasure W/T, W/GAYP, W/T/C, and Pony Hunter Pleasure W/T, W/GAYP, W/T/C.

OPEN/VHSA WORKING HUNTER- Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 2'6".

VHSA CHILDREN'S/JUNIOR EQUITATION- Open to juniors mounted on horses. The judges may select at least one fourth of the class to show at a walk/trot/canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion. Jump heights can be determined by each show. Shows may combine any of the three equitation classes. A rider can participate in only one equitation class per show with the exception of the VHSA equitation on the flat class. Fences 2'6"

VHSA ADULT AMATEUR EQUITATION- Open to adult amateurs mounted on horses. The judges may select at least one fourth of the class to show at a walk/trot/canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion. Jump heights can be determined by each show. Shows may combine any of the three equitation classes. A rider can participate in only one equitation class per show with the exception of the VHSA equitation on the flat class. Fences 2'6"



## **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS CONTINUED**

**SPECIAL ADULT HUNTER** - Open to Adult Amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies. Fences to be 2'6" or 2'9". Both heights must be offered and judged together. Related distances between two jumps should be no less than 60' (4 strides). Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Horse/rider combination cannot compete over fences higher than 2'9" at the same horse show. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the pony hunter division at the same horse show. The Special Adult Hunter division and the Special Children's Hunter division may be combined if there are fewer than 3 in either section.

**SPECIAL CHILDREN'S HUNTER** - Same specs as the Special Adult Hunter, except open to junior riders.

**JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 14 & Under** - Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17 and/or the Adult Equitation on the flat.

**JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 15-17** - Open to riders who have reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year, but not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & under and/or the Adult Equitation on the flat.

**ADULT EQUITATION ON THE FLAT** - Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the flat. Riders must stay within their age group if classes are split by age.

**SCHOOLING HUNTER**- Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'6".

**THOROUGHBRED HUNTER**- Open to horses registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. To be judged on performance and soundness. Fences 2'6".

**PLEASURE HUNTER 18'-2'** - Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences to be 18" and 2'. No oxers.

**PRE-BEGINNER EQUITATION**-Open to Junior and Amateur Riders in their first year of showing over fences less than 2' in height. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence height 2' or above. This division will not count against the rider's one year eligibility for the Beginner Equitation division. To be judged on rider's position and control. Division may be combined with Beginner Equitation division at management's discretion if entries warrant. Fence height 18". No oxers permitted.

## **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS CONTINUED**

**BEGINNER EQUITATION** – Open to junior and amateur riders in their first year of showing over fences 2' in height. No oxers permitted. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence heights exceeding 2'. This division will not count against rider's 2 year eligibility for the Intermediate Hunter division. To be judged on rider's position and control. Division may be split between juniors and adults at the discretion of show management.

**HOPEFUL HUNTER** -Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'3".

**INTERMEDIATE HUNTER** - Open to anyone in their first or second year of showing, on horses or ponies, excluding the Pre-Beginner and Beginner Equitation division. Fences 2'3". Once a rider shows over fences 2'6" or higher they are no longer eligible for the Intermediate Hunter division in subsequent years. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. The rider may not jump higher than 2'6" at the same horse show.

**SMALL/MEDIUM PONY HUNTER** - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Small ponies (not to exceed 12.2h) to jump 2', medium ponies (over 12.2h - not to exceed 13.2h) to jump 2'3". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony Divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

**LARGE PONY HUNTER** - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Large ponies (over 13.2h - not to exceed 14.2h) to jump 2'6". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

**VHSA PONY EQUITATION**- Open to juniors mounted on ponies. The judges may select at least one fourth of the class to show at a walk/trot/canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion. Jump heights can be determined by each show. Shows may combine any of the three equitation classes. A rider can participate in only one equitation class per show with the exception of the VHSA equitation on the flat class.

**LEADLINE**—Open to riders six years of age and under. Riders may not cross enter into any other class at the horse show.

**SWVEP \$1000 HUNTER DERBY**- Offered at 3', 3'3", and 3'6" with high options 3" higher. Open to pros and non-pros mounted on horses. This shall be a two-round classic with the first round over a traditional Hunter course with the emphasis on manners, pace and brilliance. The second round will be shown over a Handy Hunter type course, judging emphasis to be on handiness and promptness. Top 8 horses will return in the second round in reverse order of scores from the first round (lowest to highest.) Combined scores from both rounds shall determine the placings. Entry fee \$50.00 Prize Money: \$300, \$200, \$150, \$100, \$90, \$60, \$50, \$50

## **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS CONTINUED**

**\$500 SUNDAY MORNING MINI DERBY-** Non-Pro derby offered at 2', 2'3", 2'6", 2'9". This Derby is open to both horses and ponies. Pre-beginner and Beginner riders are not permitted to compete in this class. This shall be a two-round classic with the first round over a traditional Hunter course with the emphasis on manners, pace and brilliance. The second round will be shown over a Handy Hunter type course, judging emphasis to be on handiness and promptness. Top 8 horses will return in the second round in reverse order of scores from the first round (lowest to highest.) Combined scores from both rounds shall determine the placings. Entry fee \$50.00 Prize Money: \$150, \$110, \$75, \$60, \$45, \$30, \$20, \$10

### **Medal classes**

**SWVHJA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL** - Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3' that must include two changes of direction, a combination and at least three oxers. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. Same horse must be used for both phases. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points during the show year. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Adult Medal. SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Hunter Seat Medal Finals.

**SWVHJA ADULT MEDAL** - Same specs as for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal Class, except open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Ponies may be ridden by adults, but may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Hunter Seat Medal. SWVHJA Adult Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Adult Medal Finals.

**HOLLINS MEDAL**— Open to junior and adult amateur riders who have not qualified for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal, SWVHJA Adult Medal, or the Oakridge Medal during the existing or previous year; qualifiers for the SWVHJA Pony medal are still eligible. The class will consist of 2 phases, each counting for 50% of the total score. First phase shall be shown over a course of fences and will not contain a combination. The second phase will be a flat phase, shown at the walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. The same horse must be used for both phases. Martingales are permitted in the flat phase.

**SWEET BRIAR COLLEGE MEDAL**— Open to juniors and amateurs. To be shown over a course of no less than 6 jumps at 2'9". Course must include 2 changes of direction, and may contain an in and out. The judge will then have the option of testing the top 4 riders. Tests 1-10 may be used. The same horse must be used in both phases. Three competitors must complete the course for points to count. Riders may not have shown in a 3'6" or higher Equitation medal class, and may not jump higher than 2'9" at the same show. This class may be combined with other classes of similar specifications. This class is not recognized or sanctioned by SWVHJA. Finals will be held at the Sweet Briar College Winter Horse Show in December. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points, or be in the top 15 point earners for the year. Riders may continue to compete throughout the year

## **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS CONTINUED**

OAK RIDGE MEDAL CLASS: Open to juniors and amateur riders. Over fences phase will consist of a USEF-type equitation, A-O/Jr. jumper course of at least ten fences at a height of 3'-3'3" with spreads to 4'. Flat phase to count 50% & must run first. No martingales in the flat phase. Top ten riders will be called back for the over fences phase. Jump order is determined by judge. Judge may require additional tests from USEF tests 1-19. Minimum of 3 to fill class

SWVHJA PONY MEDAL - Open to current junior members of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. The same pony must be used for both phases. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If no Pony Medal is offered, a rider may compete on a pony in the Hunter Seat Medal. A rider cannot compete in both the Pony and the Hunter Seat Medals in one show, nor can they participate in both aforementioned finals in one year. SWVHJA Pony Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Pony Medal Finals.

### **Jumpers**

NOVICE CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER (2'6")- Open to children & amateurs in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in jumper classes at .80m (2'6") or higher as of Dec. 1st of the current show year. Riders in this division may only cross enter into Novice Jumper, if eligible, Thoroughbred and Low Jumper at the same show.

VHSA THOROUGHBRED JUMPER- Limited to horses who are registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. Fences not to exceed .80m (2'6").

LOW JUMPER: Fence heights in each class shall be no lower than .80m (2'6") in height and no greater than .90m (3') in height.

CHILD/ADULT JUMPER: Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior or adult amateur exhibitor. Fences .95 to 1.05 meters.

SCHOOLING/LEVEL 3 JUMPER: Fence heights in each class shall be no lower than .90 (3') in height and no greater than 1.10m (3'6") in height. Spreads shall be no greater than the height of the fence.

MODIFIED/LEVEL 4: Fence heights in each class shall be no lower than 1.10m (3'6") in height and no greater than 1.20m (4') in height.

### **Exhibition Classes**

EGG & SPOON CHALLENGE- Open to rider 17 & under. Riders are provided an egg and spoon and have to balance the egg on the spoon without using their fingers. Riders should be able to walk, trot, canter, halt and back-up. Whoever has the egg on their spoon the longest wins the class. This is an unjudged class.

SIT-A-BUCK CHALLENGE- Open to rider 17 & under. Riders must be able to ride bareback for the class and be able to walk, trot, canter, halt and back-up. Every rider must provide \$1 as their entry fee and place their dollar between their inner thigh and the horse. Rider must do as the announcer says. Rider who keeps their bill the longest wins. This is a Winner-Takes-All class: the winner will receive all other competitor's entry fee.
