> Below are instructions to enter online.

What you need:

- A free account at HorseShowsOnline. If you don't already have an account you can create one
 when you click the continue button below. HorseShowsOnline basic member is FREE.
- A record in your account for each person and horse that you will use on show entry forms when
 you enter a show.

How do I get started:

- Login to HorseShowsOnline by clicking the "Member Services" button in the main menu, OR click the continue button below.
- 2. Once you are logged in, click the "My Horses, People, Shows" button in the member menu.
- 3. At the People, Horses, Shows page, add any new people and horses to your account as required on the appropriate tab (IE: My People, My Horses). People and horses are saved with your account. Once you have those records in your account you can use them at every show you enter.
- 4. Click the "Enter show" button to select the show you want to enter and follow the steps in the online entry wizard.

Steps to enter a show:

- Select the show you want to enter from your "My People, Horses, Shows" page on the
 "My Show Entries" tab, or find the show you want to enter in show selector and click
 the Online Entry icon. This will start the online entry wizard. Make sure you have
 already created the horses and people in your member account.
- The online entry wizard will guide you through the steps to complete the entry form. The basic steps in the wizard are:
 - 1. Select the horse, people, and riders for your entry
 - 2. Select the classes each rider is entered in.
 - 3. Select the quantity for stalls and other fees.
 - 4. Confirm your selections
 - 5. Checkout and submit the show entry.
- The final step generates the completed entry form and submits your entry to the show for review and acceptance. If the show requires a payment at entry time, you will be prompted for your credit card information.

Tips:

- You can cancel the entry part way through the wizard and resume the entry later on. For
 example if you need to add more people to your account, or you just want to come back and
 complete the entry later. Unfinished entry forms are listed in your "My entries" tab and will
 allow you to edit the entry.
- People and horses you create in your account are saved permanently and can be used in
 other shows you enter. You only need to add people and horses once and then they can be
 re-used.
- If a horse or rider is showing in a class where a membership is not required, you can enter 00000 in the membership field.

>FEES

- Stalls \$175/week arrival Monday, May 5-NO EARLIER THAN 9 AM
- Office fee \$30/Horse
- USEF fee \$23/Horse

➤ PRIZE MONEY AND RIBBONS TO BE AWARDED

Prize money will be credited to your show account against your entries and stalls. Any other funds due to the competitor will bepaid out within 30 days following the show. Social Security and tax information must be provided to the show office prior to the distribution of any monies.

>PRACTICE AND SCHOOLING For safety purposes, an official lunging area will be posted. No lunging will be permitted outside of this area. Practice and schooling will be allowed in the arenas and coliseum until one hour before each session. Schooling hours and places will be posted for all areas.

>STABLING Permanent 12 x 12 and 10 x 10 stalls with doors. Temporary stalls may be used if entries warrant. Stalls are assigned at Management discretion. Horse stalls must be kept clean with adequate bedding while on the grounds of VHC. Bedding must be purchased through the VHC Stable Office. Outside bedding is NOT allowed without the approval of VHC and/or show management to ensure it meets the state and local environmental rules and regulations.

>ARENAS The Bonnie Blue National Horse Show is held in the Howard P. Anderson Coliseum. Arena sizes and footing: Coliseum is 150' x 300' (Sand), Wiley Ring is 150' x 280' (Kruse Cushion/Sandy), Northern Arena is 128' x 272' (Sand and Loam). Fletcher Ring is 110' x 240' (Sand and Loam). Schooling areas are regulation size and composed of materials similar to their accompanying show ring.

>CLASS CALLS/GATE HOLDS Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system. However, due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. A two (2) minute gate rule will be strictly enforced.

>ATTIRE All riders, drivers and attendants must be properly attired to enter the show ring.

>BOX SEATING Reserved seating is available in the box seating area of the coliseum. These seats are limited and will be reserved on a first come basis. A box containing twelve reserved seats is available for \$200.00 during the week of the Bonnie Blue National.

- LEASH REQUIREMENTS All dogs must be kept on a leash. No dogs are allowed in the Coliseum (Except Guide and/or service dogs).
- > PARKING No parking will be permitted in the front of, around or near the barns due to fire regulations. All vehicles must be parked only in the designated parking area.

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>PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO Photographs will be taken by Shane Shiflet during the sessions and will be available directly through her. Video will be provided by Richfield Video. Arrangements may be made before the session or by calling 1-800-345-2429. Commercial Photographers at all national shows are limited to PRESS PHOTOGRAPHERS ONLY. Press photographers (anyone taking pictures for newspapers or periodic publications) will be required to sign an agreement stating that they will abide by official Bonnie Blue Nationals Horse Show rules and any photographs they take are to be used for editorial purposes only and are NOT TO BE SOLD under any circumstances. Only one press pass will be issued per publication. Once an agreement has been signed, an official BBN Press Pass will be issued. Press passes can only be obtained from the horse show office. Cameras with detachable lenses or lenses of more than two inches are prohibited. Any lenses greater than two inches is considered professional equipment and is not permitted in the arena buildings or into the competition arenas to include seating areas. The official show photographers are exempt from this policy. Professional photographers may not record the event with any kind of camera, or video equipment. This policy will be strictly enforced. Violation of the policy may result in removal from the show grounds. Commercial photographers found violating this policy will be accessed a \$1000 fee and escorted off the grounds.

>CAMPER SPACES Camper spaces are available but limited. Spaces will be assigned on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED basis upon check-in at the STABLE OFFICE 540-464-2966. Spaces are \$40 per day and are to be paid for at the stable office. Fee includes electricity and water. Dump service is available on the horse show grounds.

>IT'S THE LAW All used needles and syringes must be deposited in the Red BioHazard Containers located at the wash racks in each barn. Violators will be prosecuted.

USEF - GR1210.4- regarding Sharps Containers. Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Competition management will place a notice of this requirement either in its prize list or on a specific handout given to trainers on check in at the competition. If local law has different requirements, local law will prevail. Competitions failing to comply with placing the required number of containers on the show grounds will be considered in violation of the rules and may be subject to penalty as determined by the CEO or his designee and/or the Hearing Committee.

>SB 103.13. Attention getting devices &/or other noisemakers (including but not limited to tape measures, blow horns, bamboo poles, explosives, fire extinguishers, baby powder, whips longer than 6', etc.) are not allowed in and around the make up and competition rings during scheduled competition sessions. All such items will be confiscated and offenders will be reported to the USEF. (See also GR839.4i)

➤USEF Membership Statement Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

MINORS OPERATING MOTOR VEHICLES/ELECTRONIC DEVICES (USEF1301.7 and 1301.8)

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

8. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The Bonnie Blue National Horse Show, the Virginia Horse Center Foundation, the Horse Show Manager, or any employee of the Horse Show shall in no way, jointly or individually, be responsible for any loss, accident, damage or loss of life that may occur to any exhibitor, owner, trainer, agent, groom, stable, corporation, partnership, individual, or spectator sustained while at the Bonnie Blue National Horse Show. This shall be incorporated as a condition of entry or admittance to the Bonnie Blue National Horse Show.

>ENTRIES AND ENTRY BLANKS To be eligible to participate as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer at Federation Licensed Competitions, persons must be Members of the Federation as provided in Bylaw 212. Coaches, trainers, and legal guardians signing as coaches or trainers on behalf of their minors must be Senior Active Members in good standing, as defined herein. Non-member riders, drivers, handlers, vaulters, longeurs, owners, lessees, and agents must pay a Show Pass fee at https://www.usef.org/show-pass.

Owners, riders, drivers, handlers and trainers of horses competing at Federation licensed competitions breed/discipline sections must have the appropriate association memberships and show the horses in the proper ownership. See USEF division rules for each section.

Health certificates required for all out of state horses. Current negative Coggins Test dated within twelve months of show required for all horses.

>UPHA CLASSICS Entries in the UPHA Classic classes must be eligible and registered with the UPHA. Initial entry fee of \$50.00 is to be made on the BBNHS entry forms. Final entry fee of \$50.00 must be made prior to the class.

>MEASUREMENT CARDS

American Saddlebred Pony, Hackney-Harness Pony, and Roadster Ponies must present an up-todate measurement card or form before numbers will be issued for the show. See each division for registration paper requirements. Time and place for measurements will be posted.

- > BEDDING All bedding must be ordered from and paid for at the STABLE OFFICE 540-464-2966.
- > CLOSING DATE All entries must be received by APRIL. Entries must be completed in full, signed and accompanied by full payment. Post entries accepted with full fees and a \$35.00 post entry fee per horse, but must be accompanied *with either a check or an open signed check. All post entries must be made one hour before the start of the session. A \$100.00 fee will be charged to those entries made less than one hour before the start of the session or without an open signed check.
- > CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS Management reserves the right to combine or cancel any class with less than three entries. Management reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without notice prior to or during the show.
- > PAYMENT & CHECKS Payment in full is due upon receipt of completed entry form. An open check made payable to BBNHS / VHCF may be used. All checks returned for non-payment will be charged a \$50.00 handling fee and must be replaced by a certified check or cashier's check within 10 days of notification. All international payments must be made either by certified funds, credit card or cash. USEF will be notified of any noncompliance with this. Credit cards are accepted at 4% transaction fee.
- **REFUNDS** No refunds will be made after **APRIL 16**. If a request for a refund is received by prior to May 1 and accompanied by a veterinary certificate, all entry and stall fees will be refunded less a \$35.00 handling fee.
- Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
- > HEALTH REGULATIONS All horses must have a current negative Coggins Test dated within twelve months of show. A photocopy of a negative Coggins Test must be attached to each entry form of every horse entered on that form. Health certificates required for all out of state horses. See USEF rules for any additional vaccination requirements.

Horse Show Academy Division Guidelines/ ASBHA National Academy Guidelines The Exhibitor

- The exhibitor entries are limited to riders enrolled in a lesson program.
- Once a rider shows in regular performance classes, they are no longer eligible to show in Academy classes. Returning riders are eligible for WTC academy after a 10-year absence from the showring.
- Riders who have shown in a regular division or in a suit/coat are no longer eligible to show in Academy classes.
- A rider who has shown & been judged in Walk/Trot/Canter classes is no longer eligible to return to Walk/Trot classes.
- A rider who has shown & been judged in Walk/Trot classes is no longer eligible to show in Lead Line.
- Riders may not show in any performance division at the same show (except driving or in hand classes).
- Age of the rider is determined by their age as of December 1 of the previous year.

The Horse

- Horses must be regularly used as lesson horses.
- A horse may be owned or leased as long as that horse is used regularly by others as a lesson/school horse.
- Horses shown in Academy classes cannot be in show training but may be exercised by a professional.
- Horses should be plain shod. (Exception may be made if corrective shoeing is needed, one pad and/or wedge is allowed for the comfort of the horse)
- Hoof blacking is optional; no ribbon braiding allowed.
- School horses may cross enter regular show classes at the same show.
- Any breed horse or pony is eligible, full mane and tail.

Tack

- Horse to be tacked with saddle consistent with style of riding.
- Full or Pelham bridles or snaffle bridle with martingale. A martingale on a leverage bit is prohibited.

Attire

- To be appropriate for the style of riding/driving.
- Jodhpurs, breeches, dark pants, long sleeve shirt, with collar, tie, gloves, vest (sweater permissible in very cold weather) Riding suits and jackets are prohibited. Chaps and western hats are prohibited.
- Roweled spurs are not permitted.
- All riders should wear protective headgear that meets or exceeds ASTM standards.

Judging

- Exhibitors are judged on their skill to effectively control the horse and to show the horse to its best advantage.
- Horsemanship/Showmanship classes are judged on the rider's performance ability how well they show the horse and utilize the ring including correct diagonals and leads.
- Equitation classes are to be judged on a rider's basic equitation skills; riding on correct leads and diagonals; conveying impression of effective and easy control.
- Horses should not be asked to back, to perform an extended trot, or a hand gallop.
- Headers are permitted in the line-up; no towels or whips allowed.
- The horse **IS NOT** to be judged.



Visitor Policies

- 1. All trailers must check in at the Stable Office/Welcome Center upon arrival.
- 2. Virginia regulations require all horses participating in events or otherwise congregating have proof of a negative Coggins test. For shows and events, these documents are shown as the exhibitors check in at the Show Office. In the case of schooling horses or layovers not associated with a show, negative Coggins should be presented to the Stable Office/Welcome Center at check in.
- 3. Virginia regulations prohibit smoking in Anderson Coliseum, East Complex, and all barns.
- 4. No firearms or fireworks are permitted.
- 5. Anyone involved in theft or destruction of property will be prosecuted.

6. VEHICLES

- a. Speed limits and traffic signs are strictly enforced.
- b. Every vehicle operator must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance.
- c. Vehicles are not permitted in Anderson Coliseum, East Complex or interior of any barn.
- d. ATVs are not permitted on the VHC grounds.
- e. Scooters, bicycles, Segways, or hoverboards operated in an unsafe manner will result in a fine.
- f. Virginia Horse Center reserves the right to restrict the operation of ANY vehicle while on the premises.

7. PETS

- a. All pets must have current rabies inoculations as prescribed by the state of residency.
- b. All pets must be crated or on leash while on VHC premises. Owners of unsecured pets will incur a \$100 fine.
- c. It is expected that owners will clean up after their pets.
- d. No pets are allowed in the Appomattox Mezzanine under any circumstances except for ADA-registered Service Animals. VHC requests that service dogs be identified as such.

8. ALCOHOL

- a. All applicable ABC laws will be followed at events serving alcohol.
- b. Individuals, not presenting proof of age when requested, will not be served.
- c. Disorderly patrons will be removed from the premises.

9. EXHIBITORS

- a. Every horse-occupied stall will have a minimum of one bale of shavings, which may be purchased at the Stable Office/Welcome Center. Sawdust is prohibited.
- b. Exhibitors, Trainers, and Owners will respect "No Lunging" signs as posted in arenas.
- c. No horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out overnight.
- d. For the health and safety of all, nothing should be attached to or suspended from the electrical conduit in the barns.
- e. No trash or sharps will be disposed of in the manure pits. Sharps should be placed in the appropriately labeled containers in each barn. Non-compliance will result in a \$1000 fine assessed to the show.
- f. Exhibitors who empty trash or manure in any of their assigned stalls or any unoccupied stalls will be assessed a \$500 fine. Appropriate receptacles are available for both.

10. CAMPING

- a. Campers must register at the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
- b. Check-in and Check-out times are subject to show dates.
- c. No gray water is to be dumped on the ground; sewage dump arrangements are made through the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
- d. Campfires are not permitted.
- e. Campers must keep their sites clean, utilizing trash receptacles provided.
- f. Campsites must be left free of any damage. The cost of repairs resulting from negligence will be the camper's responsibility.
- g. No tent, camper, RV, or camping equipment shall be left unattended for more than 24 hours without express written permission from the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
- h. VHC management reserves the right to remove from the premises any camper or visitor who violates these rules.
