FROM THE NORTH OR SOUTH:

I-81 S. To Exit 191. I-64 W. 1 mile to Exit 55. Turn right on Rte 11 N. and immediately left on Rte 39 W. The VHC is 1 mile ahead on the left.

FROM THE EAST:

I-64 W. to I-81 So. to Exit 191. I-64 W. 1 mile to Exit 55. Right on Rte 11 No. and left on Rte 39 W. The VHC is 1 mile ahead on the left.

FROM THE WEST:

I-64 E. to Exit 55. Turn left on Rte 11 No. and proceed 1/4 mile to stoplight. Turn left on Rte 39 W. The VHC is 1 mile ahead on the left.

GENERAL INFORMATION



GENERAL REMINDERS

- All exhibitors must wear protective headgear at all times when mounted on the showgrounds.
- All Hunter and Equitation Classes will receive ribbons through eighth place. Noted sections will receive Champion and Reserve Awards.
- Braiding is optional in all classes and divisions
- All divisions that must be evaluated for soundness will be required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance.

SCHOOLING

Coliseum - will be set up by 11:00am Wednesday/Thursday. Schooling over fences will be allowed until 6:00pm Wednesday/Thursday, and for at least one hour after the close of the show each day, and on the flat until the ring is closed each morning.

Reel Arena - will be set up Wednesday/Thursday by 4:00pm. Flatwork only will be allowed each morning. Schooling will be allowed after the show Friday for at least one hour and on the flat each morning until the ring is closed.

STABLING

- Stalls (10'x12') are permanent with full sliding doors with rubber mats or packed clay flooring, and are available for \$220 per horse. Stalls are assigned at management discretion. **ALL HORSES STAYING IN STALLS WILL BE CHARGED FOR A STALL.** Only horses/ponies under the same ownership will be allowed to split stalls. Feed, hay, and bedding are available for purchase at the stable office. ***Bedding orders may be called in at any time to 540-464-2966*** (stable office). Pre-orders will be accepted only with a credit card or open check.
- If you enter online, **you still need to reserve stabling on the form provided.**
- Horses not reserving stalls will be charged a \$45 grounds fee.
- Sharps containers are placed in convenient locations on the Competition grounds.

ENTRIES

- Post entries (postmarked after 1/12 or 2/24) will be accepted with a \$35 late fee.
- Entry forms must be filled out completely, including all classes or divisions entered, signatures, ID numbers, and organization or membership numbers before numbers will be issued. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in preparation of their entry forms. **AN OPEN CHECK IS REQUIRED BEFORE NUMBERS CAN BE PICKED UP.** Include copies of Amateur and Measurement cards with entries.
- The State of Virginia requires the show to possess a copy of a negative **COGGINS CERTIFICATE** from every horse on the show grounds. The copy must be presented and left at the Horse Show Office before numbers can be issued.
- **As per USEF GR 845, horses entering the show grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.**
- Current USEF waiver and release of liability must be signed in person or electronically before numbers picked up.
- An office fee of \$40 will be assessed on all entries. This includes EMT and Security fees. A \$35 fee will be charged if office staff close out a check on entries at the end of the show.
- Prize money will be credited at the horse show upon check-out. Prize money in excess of fees will be mailed within 30 days.
- All accounts must be settled within 60 days of the end of the competition. A processing fee of \$50 plus collections fees will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
- Class adds done in the show office by the evening before will incur **NO PENALTY**. Classes scratched in the office at any time will incur **NO PENALTY**.
- Horses with stalls who are not entered in classes will be charged a \$60 non-showing horse fee. Non-showing horses without stalls will be charged a \$60 Schooling fee plus a grounds fee.
- Horses scratched after the closing date of entries will receive full repayment of fees minus a \$40 office fee.

353. Collegiate Cup Team Challenge Exhibition

Entry fee: \$75 per team

This is an equitation class open to colleges and secondary schools (IEA-type) in a loose IHSA format. Schools will enter a team of three riders: Open (2'9"), Intermediate (2'6") and Novice (2'3"). Riders' eligibility will follow IHSA standards with the exception that riders qualify for the highest level that they have met regionally. Each rider will compete in an over fences and flat phase and will receive a numerical score. All scores will be totaled to determine placings. Riders may share horses. Schools are limited to 2 teams each. Horses/riders are encouraged to enter other classes at the show.

REMINDER

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba USEF ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, (i) the propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways which may result in injury to the participant; (ii) the inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or animals; and (iii) hazards of surface or subsurface conditions; (iv) the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; (v) loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; (vi) accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; (vii) facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); (viii) inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; (ix) situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and (x) other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers. ("Risks").

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.
Under VA Code Ann. Sec 3.2-6200-6203, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to re-schedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Riders may not cross enter in any other division where the fences exceed 2' at the same show except age group Equitation and Medal Classes. Riders may not cross enter into Children's Pony Hunter and Low Children's Horse and at the same show.

Fence Height:

- 2' (spreads not to exceed height offence, no in and outs allowed)

Combining/Dividing Sections:

The Low Children's Hunter and Low Adult Amateur Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section:
