DIRECTIONS TO THE VIRGINIA HORSE CENTER 487 MAURY RIVER RD • LEXINGTON, VA 24450

FROM THE NORTH OR SOUTH:

I-81 S. To Exit 191. I-64 W. 1 mile to Exit 55. Turn right on Rte 11 N. and immediately left on Rte 39 W. The VHC is 1 mile ahead on the left.

FROM THE EAST:

I-64 W. to I-81 So. to Exit 191. I-64 W. 1 mile to Exit 55. Right on Rte 11 No. and left on Rte 39 W. The VHC is 1 mile ahead on the left.

FROM THE WEST:

I-64 E. to Exit 55. Turn left on Rte 11 No. and proceed 1/4 mile to stoplight. Turn left on Rte 39 W. The VHC is 1 mile ahead on the left.

GENERAL INFORMATION



GENERAL REMINDERS

- All exhibitors must wear protective headgear at all times when mounted on the showgrounds.
- All hunter and equitation classes will receive ribbons through eighth place. Noted sections will receive champion and reserve awards.
- Braiding is optional in all classes and divisions.
- All divisions that must be evaluated for soundness will be required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance.

STABLING

- Stalls (10'x12') are permanent with full sliding doors with rubber mats, and are available for \$200/January and March. Weekend stalls (12pm Friday - Sunday) are available for \$150. Stalls are assigned at management discretion. **ALL HORSES STAYING IN STALLS WILL BE CHARGED FOR A STALL.** Only horses/ponies under the same ownership will be allowed to split stalls. Feed, hay, and bedding are available for purchase at the stable office. **Bedding orders may be called in at any time to 540-464-2966** (stable office). Pre-orders will be accepted only with a credit card or open check.
- If you enter online, **you still need to reserve stabling on the form provided.**
- Horses not reserving stalls will be charged a \$45 grounds fee.
- Sharps containers are placed in convenient locations on the Competition grounds.

ENTRIES

- Post entries (postmarked after 1/12 and 2/23) will be accepted with a \$35 late fee.
- Entry forms must be filled out completely, including all classes or divisions entered, signatures, ID numbers, and organization or membership numbers before numbers will be issued. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in preparation of their entry forms. **AN OPEN CHECK IS REQUIRED BEFORE NUMBERS CAN BE PICKED UP.** Include copies of Amateur and Measurement cards with entries.
- The State of Virginia requires the show to possess a copy of a negative COGGINS CERTIFICATE from every horse on the show grounds. The copy must be presented and left at the Horse Show Office before numbers can be issued.
- **As per USEF GR 845, horses entering the show grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by competition management.**
- Current USEF waiver and release of liability must be signed in person or electronically before numbers picked up.
- An office fee of \$40 will be assessed on all entries. This includes EMT and security fees. A \$35 fee will be charged if office staff close out a check on entries at the end of the show.
- Prize money will be credited at the horse show upon check-out. Prize money in excess of fees will be mailed within 30 days.
- All accounts must be settled within 60 days of the end of the competition. A processing fee of \$50 plus collections fees will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
- Class adds done in the show office by the evening before will incur **NO PENALTY**. Classes scratched in the office at any time will incur **NO PENALTY**.
- Horses with stalls who are not entered in classes will be charged a \$60 non-showing horse fee. Non-showing horses without stalls will be charged a \$60 schooling fee plus a grounds fee.
- Horses scratched after the closing date of entries will receive full repayment of fees minus a \$40 office fee.

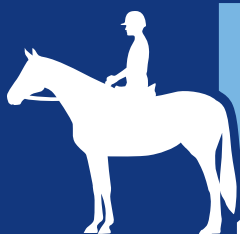

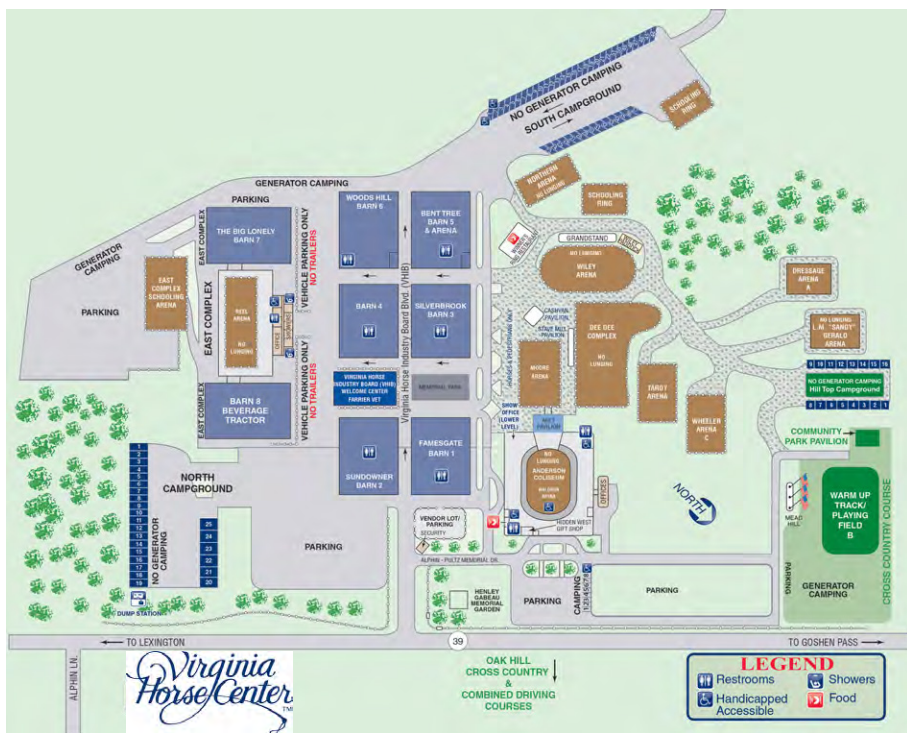

VIRGINIA HORSE CENTER VISITOR POLICY



1. All trailers must check in at the Stable Office/Welcome Center upon arrival.
2. Virginia regulations require all horses participating in events or otherwise congregating have proof of a negative Coggins test. For shows and events, these documents are shown as the exhibitors check in at the Show Office. In the case of schooling horses or layovers not associated with a show, negative Coggins should be presented to the Stable Office/Welcome Center at check in.
3. Virginia regulations prohibit smoking in Anderson Coliseum, East Complex, and all barns.
4. No firearms or fireworks are permitted.
5. Anyone involved in theft or destruction of property will be prosecuted.
6. VEHICLES
 - a. Speed limits and traffic signs are strictly enforced.
 - b. Every vehicle operator must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance.
 - c. Vehicles are not permitted in Anderson Coliseum, East Complex or interior of any barn.
 - d. ATVs are not permitted on the VHC grounds.
 - e. Scooters, bicycles, Segways, or hoverboards operated in an unsafe manner will result in a fine.
 - f. Virginia Horse Center reserves the right to restrict the operation of ANY vehicle while on the premises.
7. PETS
 - a. All pets must have current rabies inoculations as prescribed by the state of residency.
 - b. All pets must be crated or on leash while on VHC premises. Owners of unsecured pets will incur a \$100 fine.
 - c. It is expected that owners will clean up after their pets.
 - d. No pets are allowed in the Appomattox Mezzanine under any circumstances except for ADA-registered Service Animals. VHC requests that service dogs be identified as such.
8. ALCOHOL
 - a. All applicable ABC laws will be followed at events serving alcohol.
 - b. Individuals, not presenting proof of age when requested, will not be served.
 - c. Disorderly patrons will be removed from the premises.
9. EXHIBITORS
 - a. Every horse-occupied stall will have a minimum of one bale of shavings, which may be purchased at the Stable Office/Welcome Center. Sawdust is prohibited.
 - b. Exhibitors, Trainers, and Owners will respect "No Lunging" signs as posted in arenas.
 - c. No horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out overnight.
 - d. For the health and safety of all, nothing should be attached to or suspended from the electrical conduit in the barns.
 - e. No trash or sharps will be disposed of in the manure pits. Sharps should be placed in the appropriately labeled containers in each barn. Non-compliance will result in a \$1000 fine assessed to the show.
 - f. Exhibitors who empty trash or manure in any of their assigned stalls or any unoccupied stalls will be assessed a \$500 fine. Appropriate receptacles are available for both.
10. CAMPING
 - a. Campers must register at the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
 - b. Check-in and Check-out times are subject to show dates.
 - c. No gray water is to be dumped on the ground; sewage dump arrangements are made through the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
 - d. Campfires are not permitted.
 - e. Campers must keep their sites clean, utilizing trash receptacles provided.
 - f. Campsites must be left free of any damage. The cost of repairs resulting from negligence will be the camper's responsibility.
 - g. No tent, camper, RV, or camping equipment shall be left unattended for more than 24 hours without express written permission from the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
 - h. VHC management reserves the right to remove from the premises any camper or visitor who violates these rules.
 - i. The Virginia Horse Center shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses, or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by campers, arising or resulting in any respect from the camper's occupancy and use of premises and/or visitor and visitor's use of premises.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. **RULES AND REGULATIONS:** I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK:** I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

FEDERATION INFORMATION



Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to re-schedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold these horse shows, the Virginia Horse Center, their directors and employees, and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise.

Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license.
