## Visitor Policies

1. All trailers must check in at the Stable Office/Welcome Center upon arrival.
2. Virginia regulations require all horses participating in events or otherwise congregating have proof of a negative Coggins test. For shows and events, these documents are shown as the exhibitors check in at the Show Office. In the case of schooling horses or layovers not associated with a show, negative Coggins should be presented to the Stable Office/Welcome Center at check in.
3. Virginia regulations prohibit smoking in Anderson Coliseum, East Complex, and all barns.
4. No firearms or fireworks are permitted.
5. Anyone involved in theft or destruction of property will be prosecuted.
6. VEHICLES
  - a. Speed limits and traffic signs are strictly enforced.
  - b. Every vehicle operator must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance.
  - c. Vehicles are not permitted in Anderson Coliseum, East Complex or interior of any barn.
  - d. ATVs are not permitted on the VHC grounds.
  - e. Scooters, bicycles, Segways, or hoverboards operated in an unsafe manner will result in a fine.
  - f. Virginia Horse Center reserves the right to restrict the operation of ANY vehicle while on the premises.
7. PETS
  - a. All pets must have current rabies inoculations as prescribed by the state of residency.
  - b. All pets must be crated or on leash while on VHC premises. Owners of unsecured pets will incur a \$100 fine.
  - c. It is expected that owners will clean up after their pets.
  - d. No pets are allowed in the Appomattox Mezzanine under any circumstances except for ADA-registered Service Animals. VHC requests that service dogs be identified as such.
8. ALCOHOL
  - a. All applicable ABC laws will be followed at events serving alcohol.
  - b. Individuals, not presenting proof of age when requested, will not be served.
  - c. Disorderly patrons will be removed from the premises.

## 9. EXHIBITORS

- a. Every horse-occupied stall will have a minimum of one bale of shavings, which may be purchased at the Stable Office/Welcome Center. Sawdust is prohibited.
- b. Exhibitors, Trainers, and Owners will respect “No Lunging” signs as posted in arenas.
- c. No horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out overnight.
- d. For the health and safety of all, nothing should be attached to or suspended from the electrical conduit in the barns.
- e. No trash or sharps will be disposed of in the manure pits. Sharps should be placed in the appropriately labeled containers in each barn. Non-compliance will result in a \$1000 fine assessed to the show.
- f. Exhibitors who empty trash or manure in any of their assigned stalls or any unoccupied stalls will be assessed a \$500 fine. Appropriate receptacles are available for both.

## 10. CAMPING

- a. Campers must register at the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
- b. Check-in and Check-out times are subject to show dates.
- c. No gray water is to be dumped on the ground; sewage dump arrangements are made through the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
- d. Campfires are not permitted.
- e. Campers must keep their sites clean, utilizing trash receptacles provided.
- f. Campsites must be left free of any damage. The cost of repairs resulting from negligence will be the camper’s responsibility.
- g. No tent, camper, RV, or camping equipment shall be left unattended for more than 24 hours without express written permission from the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
- h. VHC management reserves the right to remove from the premises any camper or visitor who violates these rules.
- i. The Virginia Horse Center shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses, or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by campers, arising or resulting in any respect from the camper’s occupancy and use of premises and/or visitor and visitor’s use of premises.

### DIRECTIONS:

From the North – 1-81 South to Exit 191. Proceed on 1-64 West ½ mile to Exit 55. Turn right onto Route 11 North, and immediately left on Route 39 West. The Virginia Horse Center is one mile ahead on the left.

From the South – 1-81 North to Exit 191. Proceed on 1-64 West ½ mile to Exit 55. Turn right onto Route 11 North, and immediately left on Route 39 West. The Virginia Horse Center is one mile ahead on the left.

From the East – I-64W to I-81 South to Exit 191. Proceed on 1-64 West ½ mile to Exit 55. Turn right onto Route 11 North and immediately left on Route 39 West. The Virginia Horse Center is one mile ahead on the left.

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by show management whose decision shall be final
2. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management but management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of each entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.
3. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors, to change rings or rotate judges.
4. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of owner, manager, rider or caretaker shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his fees.
5. Show Management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any caretaker or horse from the show ring without being liable for compensation.
6. In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, bio hazardous medical waste containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for proper disposal of this waste.
7. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform.
8. Entries must be received by Monday June 1, 2026 or they will be considered post entries and subject to late fees.
9. Prize money will be credited towards your show account. Any other funds due to the competitor will be paid out within 30 days following the show. Social Security and tax information must be provided to the show office prior to the distribution of prize money.
10. Returned checks will be charged a \$50.00 returned check processing fee and/or any other bank associated fees and/or penalties incurred.
11. Refunds will be made upon management approval through the show office. The office fee of \$45.00 will not be refunded.
12. Current Negative Coggins paperwork must be presented along with certificates of vaccinations as required by USEF and VHC. Pursuant to GR 845 all horses must have certificate of vaccination for EIV and EHV within 6 months of the competition. **COPIES OF COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATES MUST BE PROVIDED TO THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE BACK NUMBERS WILL BE RELEASED.**

13. Permanent 12 x 12 stalls and 10 x 10 stalls with doors will be provided. Temporary stalls may be used if entries warrant. Stalls are assigned at Management discretion. Horse stalls must be kept clean with adequate bedding. Bedding must be purchased through the VHC Stable Office. Outside bedding is NOT allowed without the approval of VHC and/or show management.

14. Coliseum is 150' x 300' (Sand). Wiley Ring is 150' x 280' (Kruse Cushion/Sandy) Northern Arena is 128' x 272' (sand and loam). Fletcher Ring is 110' x 240' (sand and loam). Schooling areas are regulation size and composed of materials similar to the accompanying show ring.

15. Qualifying Pursuant to USEF Rules and SB 110

16. Horses in stalls on the grounds who are not showing must complete and entry agreement and liability statements in the show office prior to being ridden on the grounds.

17. The Shenandoah Classic Horse Show will honor the request to add a class per the following requirements are met; \$2,500 paid to the Shenandoah Classic Horse Show per class. Classes added will not count towards qualifying for the 2026 World's Championship Horse Show.

## **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

## **USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

## **You can do your entries on line**

We are offering online entries through [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com)

Below are the instructions to enter online

### **What you need:**

A free account at Horse Shows Online. If you don't already have an account you can create one at [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com). Horse Shows Online basic membership is free. A record in your account for each person and horse that you will use on show entry forms when you enter a show. Records will be saved and can be used for future shows.

### **How do I get started:**

Login to Horse Shows Online at [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com), click on the member services button on the main menu. Once you are logged in click the "My Horses, People, Shows" button in the member menu. At the People, Horses, Shows page, add any new people and horses to your account as required on the appropriate tab (ie: My People, My Horses). People and horses are saved with your account. Once you have those records in your account you can use them at every show you enter.

Click the "Enter Show" button to select the show you want to enter and follow the steps in the outline entry wizard.

### **Steps to enter a show**

Select the show you want to enter from your "My People, Horses, Shows" page on the My Show Entries tab, or find the show you want to enter in the show selector and click the Online Entry Icon. This will start the online entry wizard. Make sure you have already created the horses and people in your member account.

The online entry wizard will guide you through the steps to complete the entry form. The basic steps in the wizard are:

Select the horses, people and riders for your entry

Select the classes each rider is entered in

Select the quantity for stalls and other fees

Confirm your selections

Checkout and submit the show entry

The final step generates the completed entry form and submits your entry to the show for review and acceptance. If the show requires a payment at entry time you will be prompted for your credit card information.

### **Tips**

You can cancel the entry part way through the wizard and resume the entry later on. For example, if you need to add more people to your account, or just want to come back and complete the entry later. Unfinished entry forms are listed in your "My entries" tab and will allow you to edit the entry.

People and horses you create in your account are saved permanently and can be used in other shows you enter. You only need to add people and horses once and then can be re used.

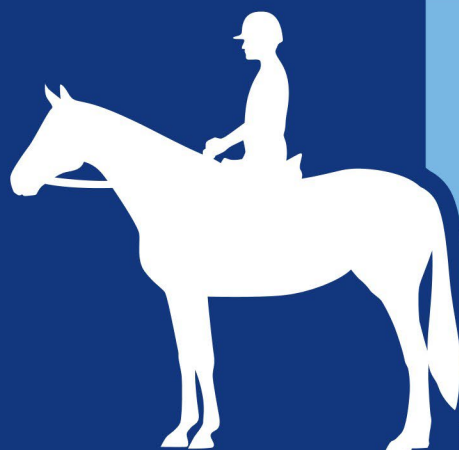

# WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and Shenandoah Classic ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

### EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E.
